NEW BUSINESS TO BE CONSIDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL

A-1 CONSIDERATION OF FIELD USE RATES FOR LA PUENTE SPORTS ORGANIZATIONS (Requested by Council Member Solis)

Council Member Solis moved to direct staff to prepare and bring back a resolution lowering the residency requirement from 60% to 51% for the reduced field use rates at La Puente Park; seconded by Council Member Storing. Mayor Pro Tem Holloway acknowledged and thanked the team moms.

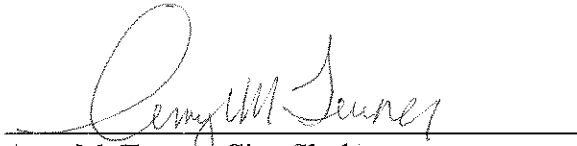
ORAL COMMENTS FROM STAFF

Assistant City Manager Yamachika noted the upcoming Halloween Festival at La Puente Park.

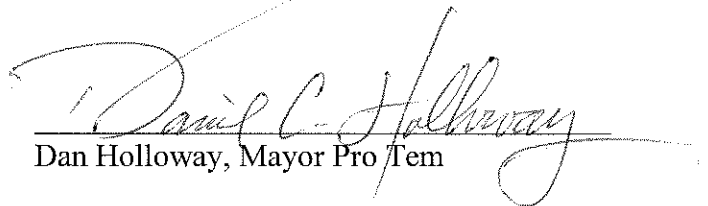
ADJOURNMENT
